Why some students may prefer an Assessment -

NZAMD is aiming to provide an alternative and positive option to the examination system with a new Assessment Programme in 2019.

An Assessment may be a more beneficial option for students having issues with timing or technique, or the degree of difficulty, or who may not want the added pressure of sitting an examination .

Are separate classes needed?

No, in the examination room assessed students will perform the same work as examination candidates, so they may continue to attend class with their friends.

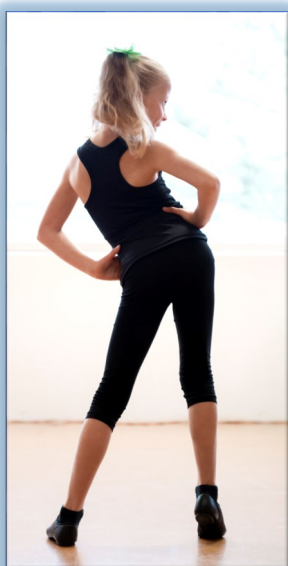
Examination & Assessment candidates may be combined in the same group on exam day.

Students may progress to an examination the following year or continue within the Assessment Programme.



Assessments will be possible -

- In all five NZAMD disciplines
- Through all Grades / Levels & Majors from Pre Grade Three
- Not available for Stretch, Leap & Spin



Entries -

- Usual Entry Forms will be used
- Assessment candidates will be shown as ASS in the column marked
- There is no change to the Entry Fee

Reports & Certificates -

- The usual Report Cards will be used - Ticks will be shown in the boxes rather than Gradings
- The result will show as SUCCESSFULLY ASSESSED
- The usual Certificates will be awarded with result shown as SUCCESSFULLY ASSESSED
