Registered Teaching membership gives the right to purchase and teach NZAMD choreography and syllabi, and to enter students for NZAMD examinations. Registration is valid for two years, and registered teachers must submit entries during that period to retain their registration. Membership Subscriptions are due annually, and only financial members may submit examination entries. There must be an awareness that when teaching in a studio NOT aligned to NZAMD, then NZAMD syllabi & choreography may not be used.

All syllabus notes and choreography, branding, and printed material are copyright to NZAMD, and may not be used by non registered persons.

NZAMD MEMBERSHIP CATEGORIES

1 - NZAMD REGISTERED TEACHER \$165 per year

- Registration gives teachers the right to purchase, use, and teach NZAMD choreography and syllabi, and to enter students for NZAMD examinations.
- Will receive newsletters and all other NZAMD information.
- Must be 20 years or over and must have passed the Advanced (or equivalent) NZAMD examination in any one of the NZAMD disciplines OR they may apply to cross-credit qualifications from an alternative organization.

Note 1: This is a membership category and NOT a qualification, and should be publicized as "NZAMD Registered Teacher"

Note 2: Upon joining NZAMD new Teaching Members will be given NEW MEMBER STATUS entitling them to special assistance from their Area Organiser and visiting NZAMD examiner. Registered Teacher status will not be conferred, nor Registration Certificates issued, until after submission of examination entries.

2 - NZAMD REGISTERED STUDIO OWNER - Non Teaching \$165 per year

- A studio owner who is not a teacher
- Must show that they employ one or more NZAMD registered teachers to allow them to buy syllabi and enter their students for examinations
- Will receive all information similar to a Registered teaching member, however they may not submit examination entries in their own name

3 - NZAMD MEMBER - Teaching OR Non Teaching \$55 per year

- This may be a student who has achieved NZAMD Advanced or equivalent examination and who may wish to do a little teaching under the auspices of a NZAMD Teaching Member
- OR a previously registered teacher who no longer teaches or submits examination entries, but wishes to retain an interest in the Association
- OR a non active NZAMD qualified person
- OR a person who has an interest in NZAMD and wishes to maintain a link with the organisation
- Associate members will receive newsletters only
- They may not enter examination students under their own name
- May not purchase syllabi

4 - NZAMD STUDENT MEMBER \$40 per year

- Must be 13 years of age or over and must have passed Elementary NZAMD examination or the equivalent level in any of the NZAMD disciplines
- Will receive newsletters only
- May not enter examination students under their own name
- A Student Member may not purchase syllabi (except when under the auspices of the NZAMD Teaching programme)
- Once Advanced or the equivalent examination has been achieved (and 18 years of age) they may choose to move to Associate Membership, OR into New Member status before progressing to a Registered Teaching Membership
